In July 2002, the Illinois Gaming Board (IGB) launched a Statewide Casino Voluntary Self-Exclusion Program (SEP) for Problem Gamblers that allows persons who have determined they are problem gamblers to self-exclude themselves from all Illinois casinos. On June 28, 2019 the Sports Wagering Act was signed into law.

Problem Gambling Self-Assessment; A study conducted for the National Gambling Impact Study Commission in 1999 estimated 3 million adults in the U.S. are considered problem gamblers.
